Six AI Pitfalls to Avoid in Your Job Search

Using AI to help with your CV or applications? Make sure you avoid these common mistakes:

- ☐ **Over-sell alert** 🚨
AI can exaggerate your experience. Don't let it claim things you can't confidently back up in an interview.
- ☐ **Tone mismatch** 🤖 vs 😊
Your CV or covering letter should sound like you. If the tone feels robotic or overly polished, rewrite it in your own voice.
- ☐ **Generic waffle** 🗨️
AI often writes in clichés or broad terms. Make sure the content is specific to your skills and tailored to that job.
- ☐ **Missing your magic** ✨
AI can miss the human story behind your career break, passion or purpose. Add your why.
- ☐ **Application fatigue** 😓
It's easy to let AI blast out dozens of applications – but this rarely leads to interviews. Employers value relevance over volume.
- ☐ **Red flag risk** 🚩
Recruiters and employers are increasingly spotting AI-generated content – and it can backfire if they think you're cutting corners.

TOP TIP: USE AI FOR STRUCTURE OR INSPIRATION - BUT ALWAYS REVIEW AND PERSONALISE EVERYTHING IT PRODUCES. YOU'RE NOT A ROBOT, SO MAKE SURE YOU DON'T SOUND LIKE ONE.
